

## Summer Christian Service Corps Scholarship Information

SCSC Scholarships are awarded to students who have:

1. Completed all their training, which includes meeting the deadlines for:
  - a. Turning in all required paperwork to the SCSC Committee
    - Completed Application
    - Proof of Current Health Insurance
    - Photo for Historical record
    - Photo ID for travel
    - Current Physical signed by a Physician (Rookies)
    - 3 Personal References names, addresses and phone numbers
    - **Fundraising Pre and Post plans and recorded efforts**
    - Dedicated Service record signed by supervisor(s)
    - Books used in training
    - Prayer Partner requirement
    - Signature indicating the Agreement to all SCSC Guidelines
  - b. Turning in all required paperwork to the Training Director and Staff
    - All Assignments
    - Safety in Ministry signature (indicating completion of training and willingness to follow those guidelines.)
  - c. Timely completion of any other requests from SCSC Committee, Training Director, or Training staff.
2. Successfully Completed the Classroom Leadership Training Course provided by the SCSC Committee and the SCSC Training Staff:
  - Active participation and cooperation in all classes and required activities
  - Preparation of a Testimony or Testimonies that meets the requirements of the Training Staff
  - Completion of assignments
  - Preparation of materials supplied by the Project Director for the project
3. Successfully completed the four weeks of On-Site Project – Practical Experience in the Field:
  - Positive evaluations from the Project Director
  - Student has shown good effort and growth in leadership skills
  - Student has participated and been cooperative to the best of his/her abilities
  - Student has been open to the guidance of the Holy Spirit and willingly worked as an instrument of God in the lives of those he/she has served
4. Student has walked and talked, throughout training and project, as a true believer in Christ, modeling his/her relationship with the Lord to others, sharing his/her Faith as the opportunities are presented.

SCSC Scholarships are awarded after a student has:

1. Attended and actively participated in Evaluation and the SCSC presentation during the Conference sessions at the end of their project.
2. Completed and turned in an Application for the Scholarship to the Memorial Board, stating the College or University the student will be attending.
3. Been recommended by the SCSC Committee/Training Staff after Evaluation and Review of Performance with the Project Director has been completed.

SCSC Scholarships are awarded according to the years of Service.  
They are distributed by semester =  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the amount per semester.

1<sup>st</sup> Year = \$1,500  
2<sup>nd</sup> Year = \$2,000  
3<sup>rd</sup> Year = \$2,500  
4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Year = \$3,000

Students who are not enrolled in a college or university will not receive their scholarship until such time as they enroll.

Students may request their scholarship later when they are enrolled in college or a university. As of the time of this revision, there is no limit to how many years a student may wait to request and use his/her scholarship.

\*\*\* Failure to meet any two deadlines will result in a recommendation for a \$200 reduction from the scholarship. Failure to meet any three deadlines will result in a recommendation for a \$500 reduction from the scholarship.
